

OUT-OF-TOWN CALLS

An Interexchange Rate Applies on a Call to any Telephone Beyond Your Local Service Area

Station-to-Station

A Station-to-Station Call is one on which you talk with ANY ONE WHO ANSWERS at the called telephone.

FEATURES OF STATION-TO-STATION CALLS

1. They are completed more quickly.
2. The rates are less than on Person-to-Person Calls.
3. There are no Report Charges. (An exception is a Collect Call on which the party at the called telephone refuses to pay the charges.)
4. Reduced rates are in effect during the evening and night hours if the initial period rate exceeds 25 cents.
5. Charges begin when called telephone is answered.
6. Charges may be made collect without any change in rate when the initial period rate is 25 cents or more. When the initial period rate is 20 cents, a collect Station-to-Station rate of 25 cents applies, and when less than 20 cents, the corresponding Person-to-Person classification and rate applies, provided Person-to-Person service is available.

Person-to-Person

A Person-to-Person Call is one on which you talk with a PARTICULAR PERSON (or Private Branch Exchange Station) SPECIFIED BY YOU.

FEATURES OF PERSON-TO-PERSON CALLS

1. A 3-minute period from start of conversation is allowed before overtime charges begin.
2. If the called telephone is reached by the operator but the call cannot be completed because the person desired is not available, a nominal Report Charge is made.
3. Charges may be made collect at no additional cost.
4. An APPOINTMENT CALL, to be completed at a specified time, may be arranged for. A charge slightly higher than the Person-to-Person rate is made for Appointment Calls to points in California, Nevada, Oregon, and Washington.
5. A Messenger Call, requiring a messenger to bring the desired person to the telephone, may be arranged for. A charge, slightly higher than the Person-to-Person rate plus the charge for the messenger, is made for Messenger Calls to points in California, Nevada, Oregon, and Washington.

HOW TO PLACE CALLS TO A ZENITH NUMBER

From non-dial telephones, call the ZENITH number as you would any local number. The calling party pays no toll charge when calling a ZENITH number.
