

# OUT-OF-TOWN CALLS

AN INTEREXCHANGE RATE APPLIES ON A CALL TO ANY TELEPHONE  
BEYOND YOUR LOCAL SERVICE AREA

The principal classes of Out-of-Town Calls are the Station-to-Station and Person-to-Person services. An explanation of these services, together with an explanation of Collect, Appointment and Messenger services, and Report Charges is given below:

## STATION-TO-STATION CALLS

A Station-to-Station Call is one on which you are agreeable to talk with ANYONE WHO ANSWERS at the called telephone. The rates are less than on Person-to-Person Calls. Reduced Station-to-Station rates are in effect from 7:00 P. M. to 4:30 A. M. daily and all day Sunday unless the initial period rate is thirty-five cents or less.

## APPOINTMENT CALLS

Appointment Calls are Person-to-Person Calls on which you wish arrangements made in advance with the station or person to be called to talk at a specified time.

## MESSENGER CALLS

Messenger Calls are Person-to-Person Calls requiring the use of a MESSENGER to secure attendance of a designated person at the called telephone.

## REPORT CHARGES

A limited charge known as a Report Charge is made under certain conditions such as on uncompleted Person-to-Person, Appointment, Messenger, and Collect Calls if the called telephone is reached but communication is not established for reasons beyond the control of the Telephone Company.

Rates and other information may be obtained from Long Distance.

For information regarding the placing of Out-of-Town Calls see Page I and paragraphs below.

## PERSON-TO-PERSON CALLS

A Person-to-Person Call is one on which you wish to talk with a PARTICULAR PERSON SPECIFIED BY YOU. If you desire connection with a particular station of a private branch exchange without specifying a particular person, this is also classified as a Person-to-Person Call. Reduced Person-to-Person rates are in effect from 7:00 P. M. to 4:30 A. M. daily and all day Sunday unless the initial period rate is fifty cents or less. Person-to-Person service is available over all routes where the initial Station-to-Station rate is ten cents or more.

## COLLECT CALLS

Reversal of charges on Person-to-Person, Appointment, and Messenger Calls is permitted provided the called party accepts the charges.

Reversal of charges on Station-to-Station Calls is permitted when ANYONE ANSWERING accepts the charges and when the initial period rate is 25 cents or more. When the initial period rate is 20 cents, a Collect Station-to-Station rate of 25 cents applies, and when less than 20 cents, the corresponding Person-to-Person classification and rate apply, provided Person-to-Person service is available.

Collect Calls are not accepted to points outside of the United States, Canada and Cuba.

## International Telephone Service

International Telephone Service is available from your telephone to most points in Europe, and to various points in Africa, Asia, Australia, Central America, South America, as well as the Bermuda, Canary, Hawaiian, Philippine, and other islands. Telephone service is also available to points in

Canada, Cuba, Mexico, and to Juneau, Alaska.

"Ship-to-Shore" Service is available to and from passengers on many ocean liners.

Calls may be placed to foreign points and ships, or rates and other information may be secured, by merely calling Long Distance.

## How To Place Out-Of-Town Calls

### Station-to-Station Calls

It is always desirable in placing STATION-TO-STATION Calls to nearby points, to give the operator the number of the telephone at the distant point. If you do not know the number, please refer to your directory. If the number is not listed, Information may help you. To place a Station-to-Station Call, give the operator the name of the place and the telephone number you are calling. Give your telephone number to the operator when requested.

STATION-TO-STATION CALLS TO POINTS BEYOND THE NEARBY VICINITY should be placed in the manner suggested in the preceding paragraph. If you do not know the number, say for example, "San Diego. Anyone at the residence of John Brown, 4000 Highland Boulevard."

### Person-to-Person Calls

To place a Person-to-Person Call, give the Operator the name of the place, the telephone number, and the name of the person with whom you wish to talk. If you do not know the number, say for example, "San Francisco. John Brown, of John Brown Co., 1000 Cass Street." Give your telephone number to the operator when requested.
