SEVENTY-TWO HOURS OF STEADY RAINFALL

A steady down-pour of rain of the kind that cheers the heart of the rancher, vegetable and fruit growers, started in last Friday night and did not stop for more than an hour or so at any one time until early Monday morning, fell throughout this valley, and in fact all over California. The heaviest rains came Sunday afternoon and night, which brings the precipitation in the harbor district for the storm up to nearly three and one-half inches, passing last season's total by a good margin.

Many freakish incidents happened as the result of the storm, causing many to be late to their employment, hiking parties caught in the mountains, streets flowing over curbs, and many marooned in the streets of nearby towns and in Los Angeles districts. River washes were inundated, canyons roaring with the violent streams of water passing on down to the lowlands, and caused a menace to wayfarers and to some property. Stores in San Pedro were flooded in some sections and streets were like rivers at times Sunday night.

The value of the rains to the agricultural districts of the state is variously estimated to be well up in the millions of dollars.
