San Francisco feels strongly the urge to give succor to stricken Japan.

for Japan was the first nation to send financial aid to San Francisco following the earthquake and fire of 1906. Also, she sent the largest contribution of any single nation, \$234,960.10. Of the 10,000 Japanese made homeless here by that disaster, only 100 received assistance from this fund. The total fund sent San Francisco by all nations and cities at that time was \$9,116,944.11.
