PLAN STAGETTE FOR WOMEN'S AUXILIARY AT LEGION MEET

SAN FRANCISCO, Aug. 15.—A "stagette" for the lady legionnaires, and by the lady legionnaires, is one of the proposed entertainment events for the American Legion's national convention in this city next October. Miss Dixie Buolware and her sister legionnaires of the various local legion posts secured the hearty approval of Gen. Liggett, convention chairman, of their idea that an affair strictly for the visiting lady legionnaires would be a most appropriate event on the national convention entertainment program, the function to be staged Tuesday evening, Oct. 16, when the men legionnaires will be guests at a real western "high jinks" or smoker.

The affair for the ladies will be staged under the direction of the Bay county hostesses' committee composing lady legionnaires of the various American Legion posts of San Francisco and the adjoining districts. Mere men will be barred, and the entertainment program is going to be one especially arranged by the ladies themselves, assurance having been given that the func-

tion will be a real entertainment, with a banquet spread on the side served by the lady legionnaires.

The American Legion Women's Auxiliary national convention will open here Monday, Oct. 15, with several thousands of delegates and visiting auxiliary members here for the couclave. The program of receptions and entertainment for the Auxiliary will be most elaborate, and will be held under the auspices of Mrs. E. Sheppard, state president of the California jurisdiction, and Mrs. Elizabeth L. Drendell, state secretary of the American Legion Women's Auxiliary, in San Francisco.

A women's committee, comprising social and civic leaders of the fair sex, Red Cross, Salvation Army, Knights of Columbus, Y. W. C. A., and other welfare workers, and hundreds of other prominent women of San Francisco, will welcome the 150,000 visiting legionnaires to San Francisco next October.

All of which would indicate that the ladies are going to take an important part in the national convention program at San Francisco, both as guests and as hostesses.

OIL EXPO IN LONG BEACH THIS MONTH

150,000 Are Expected to Attend Big Event

LONG BEACH, Aug. 16.—With the sudden entrance of the Torrance and Lomita oil districts into the great potential oil districts of California comes the first annual Oil and Land Exposition to the mother pool—Long Beach.

The exposition will be the greatest thing of its kind ever attempted in California, and with oil and land as California's greatest assets over 150,000 persons are expected to attend the ten-day attraction which will be staged at Daugherty's aviation field from August 25 to September 3, inclusive. The affair promises to have state-wide appeal, especially in this section, where millions of dollars and thousands of barrels of oil have been reaped from the major fields of California.

The exposition will be staged under the auspices of the North Side Chamber of Commerce and under the personal supervision of Saint Millard, showman of international repute.

A crew of carpenters under the supervision of Robert Stevens, former technical director of the Norma Talmadge studios, are on hand, and actual work of constructing the exhibit grounds is under way.

In conjunction with the regular educational exhibits, ten acts of vaudeville, fireworks and other feature attractions will be held.

The rodeo will be one of the most unique things that has ever been put on in California. The arena will accommodate 40,000 persons. The exposition and rodeo so far has been advertised within a radius of 200 miles.
