The object of this board in Torrance is to advance and protect the real estate dealers and brokers as well as their clients, and the public in general, from unprincipled and dishonest dealers and to advance the general welfare and prosperity of the city of Torrance.

One of the principal points brought out at this meeting for the betterment of the city was the doing away with the "For Sale" signs. No "For Sale" sign will be used by any member of the board on any city property of less than four lots in a subdivision.

Special effort is being made to have all real estate brokers who are eligible to become members by the next meeting, the charter roll having been held open for thirty days to allow the brokers now in Torrance to become charter members.

With Mr. Renn as president, the officers are: M. L. May, first vice president; W. H. Gilbert, second vice president; R. J. Deninger, secretary-treasurer.

Regular meetings of the board are to be held on the first and third Thursdays of each month.
