Baked Tomatoes with Rice Filling.—Six medium-sized smooth tomatoes, one minced sweet red or green pepper, one-half cup cream sauce, sugar and paprika, one cup cooked rice, salt, one teaspoon minced parsley and onion. Cut a

slice from the stem end of smooth tomatoes and remove the seeds and part of the pulp, then sprinkle the inside with salt, sugar and paprika. Combine the rice, cream sauce, parsley and onion, season with salt to taste. Fill the tomato cups with mixture and top with buttered crumbs and a little grated cheese. Bake in oven until done.

Peach Cake.—Two tablespoons butter, one cup sugar, one and one-half cups sifted flour, two teaspoons baking powder, whipped cream, two eggs, one-half cup milk, one-quarter teaspoon salt, peaches. Cream together the sugar, butter and eggs, add the milk, and beat up until light; then add the flour, to which baking powder and salt have been added. Bake in three layers and spread with peaches that have been peeled, sliced and sugared. Serve with whipped cream.

MENDING

In mending baby's clothes or other garments made of sheer material, a fine piece of footing may be set under the thin place or small tear. Then darn with a very fine thread using the net as a foundation. If carefully done the work will not show badly and the net is very strong.

New neckbands may be put on men's shirts and the French cuffs reversed when worn. The place at the neck in front where the collar rubs can only be mended by as neat a patch placed on the under side as the mender can manage.

Veal Cutlets Baked.—One cup strained tomatoes, one teaspoon minced parsley, one-quarter teaspoon paprika, cutlet of veal (two pounds), one teaspoon minced green pepper, one-half teaspoon salt, one large onion. Slice the onion very thin and place in bottom of hot-plate bake dish, add the cutlet, then pour over the strained and seasoned tomato sauce. Bake half an hour. Remove to platter and pour the sauce around it.

Pineapple Salad.—Sliced pineapple, lettuce leaves, chopped nut meats, two pimentos, cream mayonnaise. Arrange lettuce leaves on individual plates and place a slice of pineapple on each, sprinkle the top with chopped nut meats, and then arrange the pimentos cut into thin strips. Add a fourth cup of mayonnaise to half a cup of heavy cream, sprinkle with paprika, and put on salad.

This is a particularly interesting menu of Hungarian dishes. The recipes are well worth trying and filing for the time when we want to give the family or guests "something different."

Apple Pita.—One-half pound sweet butter, one pound flour, one tablespoon sugar, yolks of two eggs, one-half cake yeast, grated rind of one-half lemon, one pint of sour milk, little salt.

Filling: Five big apples, sliced, one cup sugar, two tablespoons seedless raisins, two tablespoons bread crumbs, juice and grated rind of one-half lemon, two tablespoons cinnamon.

Rub the butter with the flour with the fingertips until it forms fine crumbs. Then add sour cream, yeast, one egg yolk, lemon rind, sugar, salt, and knead to a smooth paste. Divide into two pieces, line the baking pan, fill with apples covered with second piece. Brush with beaten egg yolk. Bake forty-five minutes, or until brown.

Jellied Fish.—Take fish (about one or two pounds), two big onions, one carrot, one piece of garlic, one green pepper, salt, two teaspoons sweet paprika.

Slice the cleaned fish, salt and put it on ice for one to two hours. In the meantime put on fire in a quart of water all the vegetables and let them boil under cover until done. Put through sieve, salt the juice after tasting, add the fish, and let all cook for five minutes. Cool it off and put it on ice.


Hungarian Chicken Paprika.—One frying chicken (about two or three pounds), two big onions, four ripe tomatoes (or two tablespoons tomato soup), one teaspoon one green pepper, two tablespoons fat (if possible chicken fat, or bacon fat), one teaspoon sweet paprika, two or three potatoes, half a pint of sour cream.

Fry half the fine-cut onions in the fat, add paprika, let it fry for two minutes with it, then add the scraped carrots, tomato, sliced green pepper and the salted chicken with two cups of water. Let it slowly simmer under cover, stir, replace gradually the evaporated water until nearly done. Add sliced potatoes and little water, let it boil until ready. Before serving, mix in the sour cream.

Cheese Pancakes.—Two pints of milk, yolk of one egg, one tablespoon sugar, six tablespoons flour, little salt.
Filling: One-half pound of cottage cheese, one tablespoon sugar, one tablespoon seedless raisins, yolk of one egg, little cinnamon. Grate the cheese, work up well with the other ingredients, fill the center of the pancakes, roll them. Keep them hot in the serving plate above boiling water.


