RADIO

The simplest and often the best ground connection can be obtained by clamping the ground wire tightly to a well cleaned water pipe. If this is impossible, the next thing to try is the gas pipe. As a last resort, a pipe or rod may be driven into the ground as far as possible and the ground wire clamped tightly to its top. If this is done the ground immediately surrounding the pipe should be kept damp by throwing water on it occasionally, or by leaving the garden hose so it will drip continually near the pipe. We have had a good deal of trouble in getting good ground connections in Torrance, due mainly to the sandy nature of the soil. Occasionally, too, there has been considerable induced noise, from power lines, in the gas or water mains running parallel to them. To get away from this we have been forced to use a "counterpoise" ground, or one which acts by capacity without actually touching the ground. If you are troubled with induction hums of various sorts, we suggest that you try the following stunt: Wind a hundred feet or so of insulated stranded wire around the under side of the house, tacking it to the beams where necessary to keep it from touching the earth. Avoid sharp bends if possible, keeping the general shape of a circle as large as possible in the space you have. Keep the wire all one piece from the set to the farthest end. You will find this ground will not only sharpen your tuning slightly but will eliminate much of the noise due to power line logges.
