Delivery of Air Mail From Here Is Cut 24 Hours

Gourdier Announces New Time-Saving Schedule From Torrance

Postmaster Alfred Gourdier announced a new schedule for air mail out of Torrance, which will cut down the time between mailing and delivery at eastern points by 24 hours.

Air mail leaving Torrance at 7 a.m., 11:17 a.m., and 1:17 p.m. will reach Los Angeles in time to catch the trains that connect with the airplane leaving Concord, Calif., at 8:45 a.m. the next day.

The new schedule will also improve the schedule between here and Reno, Salt Lake City and Cheyenne.
