

WHY SHE STICKS AROUND

WIFE SAVERS

Escalloped Bananas and Apples.—Take six fresh apples, three bananas, three-quarters cup sugar, one tablespoon butter, one-half cup boiling water, one-half cup bread crumbs from soft part of loaf. Pare, quarter and core apples, cut in thin slices. Put a thin layer of crumbs in buttered baking dish, add a layer of apples, then one of bananas. Sprinkle with sugar and dot with bits of butter. Cover lightly with crumbs, and repeat layer for layer of fruit and seasoning. Pour over boiling water and bake about 30 minutes in hot oven. If taken from oven about 15 minutes before done and chopped marshmallows added, it makes a most attractive dish.

Grapefruit and oranges may be judged by their weight. Never buy a light fruit. A heavy, thin-skinned fruit is always the best.

It is well to keep the small cottage more or less with one wall-background. One predominant color, mixed with others of course, for variety, will tend to make the place more harmonious, as well as a great deal larger.

The bedroom may have furniture painted midnight blue or gray. On the gray painted floor there may be a rose-colored linen rug, and the window curtains and bedspread may be of unbleached muslin, with edges bound in rose-colored linen and with designs such as baskets of flowers done in gay colors in applique. The same design may be used for the painted decorations on the furniture. The next bedroom may have ivory furniture, a small-sized suite, with low and slender posts on the bed. On the putty-colored floor on the chairs and as a spread for the bed, blue and white checked chintz showing a design of roses.

When fudge has been made for a day or two and is hard on the plates on which it has been poured, warm slightly and it may not only be removed easily but tastes as fresh as when made.

Thousand Island Dressing.—To one cup of mayonnaise add one-quarter cup chile sauce, one-quarter green pepper, four olives cut up, and a teaspoon of capers.

THE EMERGENCY KIT Every home should have a

small medicine chest containing the equipment that will allow you to give first aid treatment in case of accident. Here is a list of supplies for the emergency kit:

Four ounces of iodine, four ounces of glycerine, one can of dry mustard, small box of salt, soda and vaseline salve for burns, boric acid solution, bathing alcohol, six ounces of milk magnesia, package of sterilized gauze, aspirin tablets, four ounces of turpentine, cake of pure castile soap, absorbent cotton, six two-inch bandages, six three-inch bandages, hot water bottle, ice cap, six ounces of castor oil, medicine dropper, glycerine and carbolic (one ounce of glycerine, six drops of carbolic). Have your druggist prepare this. The salve for burns is made of white vaseline and baking soda. To four ounces of vaseline add one tablespoon baking soda, working the soda in well, dissolving the lumps, incorporating evenly into the vaseline.

A closet or other less ventilated place in the house sometimes gathers moisture, causing mildew. An earthen bowl filled with quicklime placed in one corner will absorb such moisture. In addition it acts as a disinfectant.

The night before you are to cook meat, rub it with a mixture of one part of mustard to three parts of salt. This dressing is particularly good for turkey and mutton, but you will like it fully as well for beef.

When making French knots, if you take the six- or eight-strand floss in your needle you will find the effect the same as when the single thread is used and wrapped several times, and the work goes much faster.

Sew loops of wide tape to the baby's stockings, then run a safety pin through the loops when pinning them to the diapers. You will find this a great stocking saver.

To improve the flavor of currants and raisins in puddings and cakes, place them in a bowl, pouring boiling water over them, and leave them to soak over night. Drain and fry in oven before adding to other ingredients.
