Courses for teachers of vocational education and those in departments maintained under the provisions of the state and federal vocational education acts and the state compulsory part time act will also be included in the program for the summer.

Southern Branch Summer School Plans Published

The state university has announced its plans for summer sessions to be given at the Southern Branch of the University of California under the department of education. This department, always an important one, has been increased for the present year both as regards the number of courses offered and the staff of lecturers who will discuss modern tendencies in education.

Teachers of commercial work will find that the methods courses which Albert E. Bullock, supervisor of commercial education for the Los Angeles city high school district, is to give will deal with the administration of commercial departments, as well as discuss various methods used in commercial education.

Prof. Charles Clinton Peters of Ohio Wesleyan University has accepted an appointment on the summer session faculty and will conduct discussions on phases of Americanization work similar to those which were a popular feature of the demonstration last year.

The demonstration elementary school will be conducted again under Dr. Waddell's direction, and a staff of experienced teachers has been secured to supervise the classes. A unique departure for the demonstration school this summer is the nursery school, which is not to be confused with the day nurseries of our big cities, in which merely the physical needs of the children are taken care of.
