



**Atwater Kent Sales Mount To
 Total of 5200 Sets Every Day**



"Hail, my hearties, what have we here?" shouted two pirate fairies as they went wandering through Radioland. "Blast my topknots if it isn't a Treasure Chest—and a radio tube!"

They rushed to pick up the tube, and much to their surprise found it as light as a feather; and the set, too, weighed less than nothing. For, if you must know, they were both imaginary.

"Aside from being an interesting bit of composite photography," commented Ray Thomas, Atwater Kent distributor for Southern California, "this picture shows a very real comparison. If all of the hours were rolled into one big set, it would be approximately as large as the one shown in the picture."

"Likewise, if all of the voice-teated tubes sold in a like period by our organization were in proportion to the Model 35 receiver shown, they would make one tube as large as the one Miss Dorothy Rutledge and Miss Marg Hampton are supposed to be holding."

It is said that the present schedule of the Atwater Kent factory calls for the completion of 5200 sets every working day, and in spite of this tremendous production many parts of the country are having a shortage.

The Atwater Kent organization has maintained the largest sales volume of any manufacturer in the United States ever since they

started business. This year's production is expected to equal that of any two other manufacturers combined, although Mr. Thomas points out that no accurate figures are available, either for Atwater Kent sets or for other makes.

The estimate is based upon secret information from the factory, obtained at the time Thomas made his recent trip east for two carloads of Atwater Kent receivers. His foresight enabled him to fill the present high demand for sets, while other distributors are not quite so fortunate.

At the rate of 5200 sets per day, however, the strain on the reserve supply is expected to be relieved within the next two months.

**Veterans Sure
 Going to Paris
 To Legion Meet**

Reservations Flood Office at Los Angeles for Big Trip

LOS ANGELES.—With reservations flooding the local office of the American Legion's France convention office, 347 Pacific Electric building, indications are that all ships assigned to carry over the 30,000 war veterans to Paris in the fall of 1927 will soon be filled to capacity.

The French liner De Grasse has been turned over as the official Legion transport in California to take the peacetime army overseas. However, reservations may be made on any of the ships of the United States Lines. This concession was made especially to encourage the American Merchant Marine vessels, Legion officials declare. Notable among the United States Lines' ships is the gigantic Leviathan, which will be flagship of the young navy leaving for Paris in early September, 1927.

Special hours are being arranged by the majority of Legionnaires and their families through Thomas Cook & Son, 223 South Grand avenue, Los Angeles, who are official touring agents for the Legion pilgrimage to France. The time limit in round-trip tickets has been extended to include most of December, 1927, allowing ample time for veterans to see other parts of Europe, and practically all of them are taking advantage of the opportunity to go abroad.

All reservations for the Legion trip must be made through the office of Angelo Bessolo, 347 Pacific Electric building, Los Angeles. Legionnaires, Auxiliary members, their families, and fathers of veterans, are included in the Paris trip. It is hailed as the world's greatest peacetime expedition. Leading it will be Gen. John J. Pershing, honorary commander of the national organization of the Legion.

WIDEN COAST ROAD


