Woodsman Evangelist Will Speak to Four Square Gospel Church Here on Sunday Night

The Church of the Four Square Gospel in Torrance is looking forward with keen anticipation to a record attendance on Sunday night, when Evangelist Wesley Norgaard of Seattle gives in an unique illustrated message some of the incidents of his eventful life.

Mr. Norgaard, who is temporarily occupying the pulpit of the Four Square Church during the absence of the pastor, Miss Jennie Jacobson, has come in very short time from high rigging in the woods of the Pacific northwest to the preaching to large gatherings in the evangelistic work.

An important adjunct to logging operations under modern logging methods is spar trees to which are attached loading rigging, yarding rigging, and sometimes the sky-lines which carry tons of weight as the big logs come hurtling down on them from the heights. Trees that are suitable for the purpose are difficult to find, and the location, but more difficult yet is to find a man qualified to top them who can swing his axe two hundred feet in the air as nonchalantly as on the terra firma below. The man who can qualify for the job, as Wesley Norgaard has done, is not hedged about by any rules as to wages. One job of a few hours a week it is said, will give him plenty of spending money.

The preliminary work consists of cutting away all branches up to the point where the topping is to be done. With only a leather belt and the hooks in his boots to support him at the dizzy height of sometimes over two hundred feet, the high climber feels the top in exactly the same manner as does the workman who fells a tree from the ground, except that he has no assistants. He must use care that he arranges for the top to fall with the wind, and should he desire to handle further such jobs he should be careful to arrange to be on the other side of the tree when the big top, which is much larger than many trees being cut for timber elsewhere, topples over. As the top falls it puts the big stick into motion and the workman sways back and forth with it, often for a distance of 60 feet, which is said by those who have tried it to be an exhilarating form of avia-
tion.
