


National Park Chevrolet at Yellowstone

"Cotter's Hell" was the name the early pioneers of the west gave to the strange region now embraced in Yellowstone Park. The first men to visit the country and come back with stories of boiling springs, spouting geysers, crevices in the earth that growled and muttered and spit out colored mud, were set down as monstrous liars by the world at large. But when the first government expeditions returned from Yellowstone and confirmed every one of the seemingly fantastic tales, the reputation of Jim Bridger and other early explorers for truthfulness was restored.

Yellowstone was first recently to the National Park Chevrolet, the car sent out by the Chevrolet Motor Company this summer to visit all of the National Parks of the West. They discovered Yellowstone to be far the most popular of the Parks so far visited. Established by Congress in 1872 it was the first of the great chain of public playgrounds, and its fame is more widely established than any of the others. Last year more than 100,000 visitors came to Yellowstone during the comparatively short season that the park is open.

Plenty of visitors other than those of human kind come to Yellowstone. The Chevrolet party discovered. In the more than 50 years that the Park has been established hunting has been strictly prohibited. Consequently it has become by far the largest and most successful wild animal preserve in the world. Elk, bear, deer, bison, antelope and big horn sheep range the park unafraid, and their presence adds immensely to the interest and pleasure to be derived from the trip through Yellowstone.

But in addition to the grotesque and weird attractions of the geysers, hot springs, and of the wonderful animal life, the culminating attraction of the Park is the Grand Canyon of the Yellowstone, where the river hurds itself over a 200 foot precipice between the multi-colored walls of purple, vermilion, yellow and white.

Great roads in a nature of the Yellowstone greatly appreciated by motorists. It is the ambition of Supt. Horace M. Albright of Yellowstone to make all of the roads in the park the equivalent of paved highways, and the Chevrolet tourists found that he has virtually realized this in the present splendid condition of the highways.




Build and Live in Torrance

An Attractive, Roomy and Practical Bungalow

Here is a house that is utilitarian and at the same time it is attractive. English in influence; it has two large chimneys that add an air of substantiality and comfort. A feeling of cheer within.

The house is entered through a small vestibule. No space is here given over to the hall; of doubtful value since its usefulness is very

small. Then into the cheerful sun porch and thence into the cozy living room which has, as every living room should have, a fireplace, there is an attractive built-in window seat in this room.

The dining room opens from the living room on one side and the kitchen on the other, which kitchen is well equipped for convenience and comfort. The laundry tubs are in the cellar, as is the heater, cold room, etc. Three bed rooms

with plenty of light and air, and good closets together with a tiled bath complete the arrangement.

The exterior of the house is shingled, and wide shingle sides, variegated shades of shingles for the roof. This is truly a nice neat home, that will always be a source of pride and comfort to its owners.

A lot with a frontage of about 50 feet would be required to give this little house a proper setting. Its cost is about \$8300.

This Home Is Called by Designer the "Best of Its Type"

The powerful association of ideas plays a powerful though often illogical part in our opinions of the fitness of things, so that in its application to home designing it often results in a plan as illogical as the term thought.

For instance: In a house of long, low lines, red tile roof, much blank wall surface, an asymmetrical treatment of window and door openings, in other words, a Spanish type we expect white walls. There may be no real reason why red brick should not be used, but it does not seem fitting.

We would suggest in the house illustrated this week, which incidentally is one of the very best that has been shown, that the brick walls be painted white. This is a treatment that has not received attention that it merits. The effect to be striven for is that of a building that has been white-washed and has weathered until there are slight indications of the brick color showing in a few places.
