

L. A. Philharmonic Conductor on Way to United States

The program for the opening concert of the Los Angeles Philharmonic orchestra (Thursday evening, Oct. 27, and Friday afternoon, Oct. 28, had just been received from Irving Schryver, the new conductor, who is now en route to the United States. The program will open with the Prelude to "Die Meistersinger" by Wagner. Two numbers which will be given their first hearing at these concerts are "Mammal de Falla," from "The Three-Cornered Hat" and Respighi's Symphonic Poem, "The Fountains of Rome." The closing number will be the Brahms Symphony No. 1 in C Minor, Op. 68.

Sales Institute to Be Given for Southland Men

Delivering a series of lectures designed to analyze principles of salesmanship, develop promising salesmen, and aid in solving present-day merchandising problems, Dr. Paul Ivey, brought to the Southland by the University of Southern California, will conduct his fourth annual Salesmanship Institute during October and November in Los Angeles, Glendale, Long Beach, and San Diego.

Claimed by many to be the most dynamic lecturer in the United States, Dr. Ivey has demonstrated an unusual appeal to every type of audience according to N. C. Howell of the Trojan University, who is organizing the Ivey Institute. His knowledge of commercial conditions throughout America, acquired by first-hand contacts with all types of business organizations during the past five years, is coupled with a magnetic personality and "human" side. He recently lectured before probably the largest group of grocers ever gathered together in one place when he addressed 4200 at Columbus, Ohio. Dr. Ivey headed a merchandising class of 1000 at Northwestern University.

"A mind open to new ideas is essential to progress," says Dr. Ivey. "When people's minds were inflexible and static we had what were known as the 'Dark Ages.' Salesmen with modern ideas are necessary—progressive men and women who inject new ideas into business and into life are community leaders." Dr. Ivey is recognized as one of America's foremost sales counselors. Among thirty leading commercial organizations who have employed his services are Marshall Field of Chicago, Southern Pacific Railroad Company, Associated Oil Company, and Barker Brothers of Los Angeles. This last summer he had full charge of the sales convention of the National Life Insurance Company of Vermont, one of the oldest in the United States, convening at Banff, Canada.

Wife Savers

Household Helps
If a tray, the table or store-room is necessary, carry a basket to save time and strength. Keep on your desk a list of things to do—calls, letters to write, mending and other household tasks that one may forget or slight. As the task is finished cross off the list. This is a most satisfactory way of knowing what has been accomplished during a week or month. It is also an incentive to hurry up and leave a clean slate. This method is a good one for the kitchen, too; various things are forgotten that will, with a list, keep things running smoothly. A camp chair or stool, which can be stipped under the table when not in use is a great convenience in a small kitchen. Sit down as much as possible when working, save your legs for walks in the open air.

Be sure taking disagreeable medicine, hold a piece of ice in the mouth for a moment; it dulls the sense of taste. Grease the cork of the glue bottle, then it will open easily. Keep old can rubbers to set on ice when dishes are to be placed on the ice to cool. They keep the dish from slipping. When retining drawers with paper, use a small sticker to hold them in place. A fresh blood stain may be removed by rubbing with dry starch. The starch absorbs the blood and when dry it may be rubbed out leaving no mark. Anyone who has tried it knows that the housekeeping one cannot follow a schedule invariably. However the housekeeper is greatly assisted by a system which is carefully followed when possible. A slate or tablet hanging on the wall with an outline of the week's meals and extra duties will prove to be a wonderful step-saver, as well as time-saver.





Picturesque Bungalow Interestingly Planned



Pleasing touches of mission architecture in the lines of this bungalow easily identify its California origin. It departs from the ordinary, however, with the large arched front window, affording an abundance of light in the living room. Portland cement stucco has been effectively used to produce the charm of the appearance of the bungalow and combined with a concrete tile roof, its permanence and fire resistive qualities are assured. Every requirement of the medium-sized family is satisfied here on a single floor. The rooms are well proportioned, the spacious living room being especially attractive with its open fireplace. A wide archway leads into the dining room. The convenient kitchen has a snug breakfast nook and built-in refrigerator, while the inclosed rear porch may be equipped for laundry purposes. The master's bed chamber, facing the street, has a private shower-equipped bath, while the other two large bedrooms are convenient to the large bathroom in the rear of the house. Each bedroom has an extra large clothes closet. A lot fifty feet wide will provide ample space upon which to build this home and allow for the building of a concrete driveway to the garage in the rear, as was done at San Diego, Calif., where the above photograph was taken.


