

Wife Savers

Cakes for Tea
For the tea cake to serve with a cup of tea or a small cake for luncheon the following recipes will be enjoyed.

Poppy-Seed Wafers.—Take two cups of milk, two eggs, three tablespoons of olive oil or softened butter, one cup of sugar, one-fourth teaspoonful of salt, one-fourth pound of poppy seeds, two teaspoonfuls of baking powder and flour to roll. Cut in rounds and bake in a hot oven.

Creoles.—Mix all the following ingredients, beat well and bake in small fluted pans 12 to 15 minutes. Take three eggs, one and one-half cups of brown sugar, three-fourths cup of flour, one-half teaspoonful of salt, a few grains of cayenne and one and one-half cups of bean meats.

Oriental Tea Cakes.—Cream one-fourth cupful of butter, add gradually one cupful of brown sugar, heating well. Dissolve an eighth of a teaspoonful of soda in a table-

spoonful of water, add a teaspoonful of vanilla and one cupful of flour. Mix until it holds together. Make into small balls; if they crumble add a few drops of water. Place in a buttered pan or baking sheet and bake in a quick oven until delicately brown. This recipe will make 40 cakes.

Macaroons.—Mix one cupful of almond paste with one cupful of powdered sugar until the mixture is like meal. Add egg white, one at a time until three are used; flavor with one-fourth teaspoonful of almond extract. Bake on buttered paper placed on an inverted dripping pan. Drop by spoonfuls on the paper.
