I have to work very fast to try to keep up with their chic, for when there are several parties all the time. The circular skirt is very full and dips to my ankles in back, and the décolletage goes to a very low narrow point in back. Why I didn't think of it sooner, I don't know, but, of course, a black-and-white ensemble, using this dress as a basis, will be perfect.
When I set out to choose a wrap, I decided on a black one with white on it somewhere, and the

one that I have sketched is the one I found. It is made of black velvet and follows the same down-in-back line, as do all the new frocks. The wrapped front is carefully shaped to give width, warmth and aliveness, and the long and full kimono sleeves have dart-shaped tucks. On it is a wide and full white fox collar. Don't you think it looks well, even in the sketch? And when it is on, it looks even better. I have interlined it, too, so that I can wear it on the coldest days.
To wear to the very grand dance, I bought a velvet dress in the most delicate shade of oyster-white—a pale and misty, almost indefinable gray. It has a modern décolletage and a bloused bodice that tumbles softly over fitted hips, and a long, side drapery falls from a narrow belt.
