

THAT CAR OF YOURS

Hot water readily transfers its heat to the metal of the radiator core when the latter is clean. Flushing the cooling system with water or alkaline solution is conducive to the efficiency of any automobile.

Overheating of your engine is generally due to one of the following causes: exhaust valve failing to open early enough to permit the burned gas to pass out; the carburetor having too rich a mixture; ignition running on retard spark; or the cooling system not working properly. When this condition exists in the motor, an expert should be called upon to fix it.

Having front wheels properly aligned does not always stop uneven wearing of front tires. Concave spots about the entire tire are often caused by worn king pins, worn king pin bushings or steering and connecting rod bushings and pins. These worn parts result in front wheel "shimmy." This is often hardly noticed on heavier cars, but it nevertheless quickly wears tires.

Engine knocks not due to bearing trouble or other causes which are easily determined through lack of power, include what is known as the common knock, which is the ignition knock, caused by the spark advanced too much, or "back lash" in the timing gear teeth. This is a very serious condition which should be immediately checked by an expert.


