Edison Man and B. J. Scott Point Out Danger to Youth

Children of Torrance this week were served with two warnings through the medium of the schools. First warning—do not fly kites where strings may become entangled with electric wires.

Second warning—Do not open the doors of lighting standards and scrape lead off the cables. C. W. Koerner, in a letter to Principal Herbert S. Wood of the high school, declared that recently a high power line was out of commission in Torrance for an hour and a half due to a kite string.

This is dangerous. If a child's kite contacted the high voltage wires inside, he would be instantly killed, according to Mr. Scott. Principal Bell of the Grammar School issued a warning to pupils regarding the danger of tampering with the light standards.
