

THAT CAR OF YOURS

When motoring at night on wet pavements watch out for pedestrians whose vision is likely to be obscured by the rain.

Inability to start your car when the battery is fully charged may be due to one of the following causes: starter mechanism out of order, open circuit in wiring, defective starting motor, starting switch not closing, open circuit in the field armature of the starting motor.

When the battery is discharged and not charging at the proper rate, the fault may lie in one of the following causes: generator not working properly, or working and charging at too low a rate, a grounded generator circuit; defective cutout will not close; third brush not set properly. An

electrical expert should always be consulted for such trouble.


If the water in your radiator boils from the heat when driving in a mountain grade, even though you are using the proper gear to help the motor, it is best to stop and let it cool. Do not pour cold water into a boiling radiator, but let it cool, or at least keep the motor running while replenishing the radiator. If you continue to drive with a boiling motor, the heat will affect the lubricating quality of your oil and endanger pistons, rings and cylinder walls.

Adds Eight New Zone Warehouses to Care for Service Requirements

The Chevrolet Motor company anticipating the greatest sales volume in its history during 1929 has announced a building program for its parts and service department for the first six months of the year which will increase measurably, the company's already adequate coverage for owner service.

This building program, as outlined in a letter to the Torrance Motor Co., local dealer, will add eight new zone warehouses to the present number, all of them to be in operation before June 1. The departmental building program for this year has already brought about the opening at Flint, Mich., of a vast model manufacturing building, where parts for the former four models will be turned out on a volume basis.

The cities where new zone warehouses are to be erected are Wichita, Kansas; Birmingham, Ala.; Knoxville, Tenn.; Richmond, Va.; El Paso, Texas; Salt Lake City, Utah; Great Falls, Mont.; and Indianapolis, Ind. In all instances property has already been purchased and architects' plans approved. With the opening of these eight proposed warehouses the

number owned and operated by Chevrolet throughout the country will have been increased to 36.

The building program which this department is to carry on this year, according to Jack Hanson, is in accord with Chevrolet's policy of constant progress. Last year found the parts and service department effecting a building program which added to its facilities 200,000 square feet of floor space. Eight new zone warehouses were erected and placed in operation in addition to two major supply depots at Atlanta, Ga., and Kansas City.

Mr. Hanson explained that while the primary function of these zone warehouses is to bring the car owner as close as possible to the point where replacement parts are distributed, it is not the only purpose for which they are utilized by the company.

Each, he declared, maintains a service school, in charge of a resident instructor who is constantly employed informing shop foremen and mechanics in the proper repair of a car, in Duo refinishing and in all other phases of shop operation and mechanical knowledge that will make for improved service.

Flower Fete Expected to Bring Crowds to Redlands Sunday

REDLANDS, April 4—A floral parade in which hundreds of school children will participate, a flower show, a night music and flower pageant, open house at the Ariston, the old mission, a community play and garden trips each day of the week, will feature the activities of Redlands' first "Week of Flowers" scheduled for the period starting Sunday, April 7.

That the children's floral parade scheduled for Thursday afternoon, April 11 is well worth seeing, is declared by the sponsors. This is a miniature tournament of roses parade with floats in miniature and gaily decorated with flowers. All children are dressed to resemble flowers. All the civilized nations of the world will be represented in the parade.

The flower show which starts the same day will display thousands of specimens of flowers. Those who enjoy flowers will see an exhibit of merit, it is stated. The flower show is open from Thursday to Saturday night, April 13.

The Community Music Association will present a floral and dancing pageant on Friday and Saturday nights. The Community players will offer a special floor play on Tuesday, April 9 while the Contemporary club will have a special floral art exhibit on display daily. All business houses will be decorated with spring flowers.

Special days have been assigned to the service clubs, each holding special meetings for members of the organizations from other cities. The daily garden inspection trips will start on Monday, April 8. Visitors are requested to go to Community Club headquarters, where guides will accompany auto parties through Redlands' famous flower gardens, over Simley Heights and Sunset Drive.

Thousands of visitors are expected to be guests in Redlands during the "Week of Flowers" which has the backing of every organization in the city.
