


Convicts Rush Big Sur Road Work

Ramona Pageant Opens April 20 at Hemet Bowl

Talented Artists Engaged for Leading Roles This Year

Advance reservations for the Ramona Pageant, to be presented on the afternoons of April 20 and 21, April 27 and 28 and May 4 and 5,

Heyes, who will enact "Alessandro", Ramona's lover, for the first time, is nationally known for his appearances in stage productions opposite such stars as Nazimova, Marjorie Rambeau and

Anna Q. Nilsson on the screen and others. He has co-starred with her opposite Theda Bara, Constance Talmadge, Betty Blythe and others.
For the last five months he has been featured by the National Broadcasting company over the countrywide radio network, and oddly enough, he recently took part in an aerial rendition of "Ramona" from San Francisco.
With such outstanding stars in leading roles, elaborate preparations are being made by the people of Hemet and San Jacinto to outshine all previous presentations this year.

TOUGH MOTORING TO EISENADA

The road between Tia Juana and Eisenada, B. C. 69 miles, is somewhat rough at the present time, according to the Touring Department of the National Automobile Club, due to recent heavy rains. Numerous deep ruts are in evidence. Leaving Tia Juana, pavement is traversed for 1 1/2 miles, thence fair dirt and natural gravel to Doscanas, with a similar type of road over winding grades through a hilly country to within 5 miles of Eisenada. Balance of route is over an old road which is quite narrow.

Best Route to San Fernando Told

The best route between Los Angeles and San Fernando Valley points at this time is via Hollywood, Caluenga Pass and Lankershim Boulevard, according to the Touring Department of the National Automobile Club, for San Fernando Road is closed due to pipe construction, from Verdugo Road to Fletcher Drive.
