FRUIT OMELET
1 egg.
Few gratings orange rind.
1 teaspoon orange juice.
Few grains salt.
1 orange.
2 teaspoons butter.
2 teaspoons powdered sugar.
Beat the eggs slightly, adding the orange rind and juice and salt.

Peel the orange, removing all white membrane, and cut into very thin slices. Sprinkle with one teaspoon of the powdered sugar. Melt the butter in hot individual omelet pan or frying pan. Pour in the egg mixture and cook over a low heat, shaking the pan and pricking the mixture with a fork until all the mixture is cooked. Roll or fold

and turn out on to serving dish. Sprinkle with remaining sugar and surround with slices of orange.

STUFFED LAMB CHOPS
10 chops.
1 tablespoon butter.
1 tablespoon chopped onion.
1/2 cup chopped mushrooms.
1 teaspoon salt.
Pinch of pepper.
1 tablespoon flour.
2 tablespoons stock.

Trim the chops and cut very thick with sharp knife. Split each chop, being careful not to separate the meat from the bone. Put butter in a pan and add the onion, cook slowly for five minutes, then add the mushrooms, salt and pepper and cook five minutes more. Add the flour and stock and cook a few minutes more. Stuff each chop with this mixture before it cooks. Press each tightly together and broil. (If mushrooms are unavailable, bread dressing may be used, using a greater quantity of stock).
