

Telephone Company Pushing Construction to Boulder Dam

To provide telephone service into Las Vegas, Nevada, the Boulder Dam district, to desert waypoints, and to Salt Lake City, an eight-car construction train with a load of 80 telephone men left Los Angeles this month to begin work. This train, which was purchased by the company to provide moving headquarters for the men on the

job, will advance toward Las Vegas at the rate of two miles a day between Barstow and Las Vegas. The project involves an expenditure of \$250,000. This new long distance line into Las Vegas is one of the largest long distance telephone undertakings ever attempted on the Pacific Coast. It will follow the route of the Arrowhead Trail and the Union Pacific railroad. As a result of the work being done, it will be possible for 25 people in Southern California to talk to parties in Las Vegas and Salt Lake simultaneously.

In Riverside a special baggage car loaded with California oranges was attached to the train and the oranges will be distributed in Chicago to the more than 8,000 employees of the Grigsby-Grumow company who are engaged in the manufacture of Majestic Radio receivers. According to Wilson, there will be sufficient oranges to give one of California's finest to every employee of the great Grigsby-Grumow factories and present a full box of the golden fruit to many of the plant's executives. This trip will consume eight days' time and allow the dealers two days in Chicago. The trip East will be made over the Union Pacific and the dealers will return to Southern California over the Santa Fe lines. Included in the party is Mr. C. Alexander, local Majestic dealer.
