A Good Breakfast Means a Good Start

1. Sliced orange or orange juice.
Oatmeal—top milk.
Poached Egg on Toast.
Butter.
Milk.

2. Baked Apple.
Milk Toast.
Bacon.
Cocoa.

3. Cream of Wheat with Raisins.
Top Milk.
Scrambled Eggs.
Brown Toast—Butter.
Fruit Juice.

4. Stewed Dried Figs.
Fruit Juice.
Oatmeal—Top Milk.
Bacon.
Toast—Butter—Cocoa.

5. Hubbard.
Egg Baked in Milk.
Dry Toast—Butter.
Jam—Milk.

6. Stewed prunes.
Creamed Chipped Beef on Brown Toast.
Cocoa.
Coffee may be added to these menus for adults if desired.

BAKED EGGS

6 eggs.
1/2 cup milk.
2 teaspoon butter.
Sprinkle of salt.

Into flat bottomed baking dish put the 1/2 cup of milk, heated hot but not boiling; break eggs and turn into the hot milk, being careful not to break the yolks. Add


butter and salt. Bake in a moderate oven five minutes or until the whites are set and yolks are cooked as desired. Serve hot.

Individual cups or ramekins may be used for each egg if desired. In this case add one tablespoon of hot milk to each cup before the egg is put in. Serve in the individual cups.

CREAMED CHIP BEEF

1/4 cup chipped beef (chopped fine).
2 tablespoons butter.
2 tablespoons flour.
2 cups milk.

Melt butter, add flour, stir until well blended, add chipped beef and milk, stirring constantly and cook until smooth. Serve on crisp toast. (Christmas Seal Service).
