It shall be unlawful for any person to propel, or cause to be propelled, any vehicle, or other means of travel along Cabrillo Ave., between Plaza Del Amo and Bonfor Ave.; or along Sartori St., between Redondo Blvd. and Dominguez St.; or along Redondo Blvd., between Post Ave. and a point 420 feet west of Madrid Ave., except in a direction such that progress along such streets shall be along the right hand, side of the Pacific Electric Railway right-of-way which constitutes an unpaved portion lying between the two paved portions of two such streets.
