

Hints To Home Builders


FOR A CHILD'S ROOM



Among the tasks that make many a mother's hair turn prematurely gray, is that of keeping a child's room or nursery neat and orderly even a part of the time. The answer to this crying problem is a plenitude of closets and cupboards devised so that all toys and playthings can be easily tucked out of sight, yet in such a manner that the room will not appear only to be one vast system of closets.

In the room a part of which has been sketched above, we see ways in which storage space may be attractively provided. Below the window an attractive window seat has been made with cushions covered in bright colored chintz. Underneath this are cupboards whose doors pull down by means of small wrought iron rings. Open wall cupboards are let into the built-out walls which flank the window. Wall closets have been made at one side of the window and a




