Rose Gardens Attractive

Fortunately it is not necessary to have riches to enjoy roses. The humble home owner may easily have as lovely a rose garden as the rich with a large estate.

Roses are partial to a well drained and sheltered situation free from strong winds but must have the full sun. Roses do well in our heavy adobe soils but must have drainage to become established.

The ideal is to have roses the year round whether we cut them or not.

PLANTING CALENDAR
Now is the time to plant ranunculus, anemones, stocks, larkspur, calendula and pansies for winter and early spring flowers.

This month is one of the best times of the year to plant all perennial flowering plants for you will get a wonderful bloom in the spring and summer.

Lawns should be raked, reseeded and fertilized within the next two months. Citrus trees should be fertilized also.

Roses should not be watered but allowed to rest until the end of the rainy season as the natural rainfall will give them all the water that is required during their dormant period.

After this rain is over you will have another chance to prepare your roses, shrubs and lawns to take advantage of the next one.

Prepare Roses for Next Rain

The natural rainfall is one of the best sources of plant food but the conditions must be right or it will act as an unfriendly element rather than a beneficent one.

Your lawn should have a mulch or top dressing to protect the soil beneath and the root system of your grass.

The rain will carry into the ground the plant food in the top dressing thus storing it up to be used when the plants start to grow again in the spring.


