

Motor Entries Increase 22.6 Percent

A total of 304,988 out-of-state motor tourists entered California last month in 37,385 automobiles, registering an increase of 22.6 per cent over June, 1929, according to Don Thomas, executive secretary of the All-Year club, Southern California's national tourist advertising organization, who also stated that this is an increase of 19,252 auto tourists, or 22.6 per cent, over the corresponding period last year.

Federal Funds Help Combat Forest Fires

The California State Division of Forestry, Department of Natural Resources, will this year receive \$147,716 of Federal funds for forest fire prevention and suppression, according to advice just received by S. B. Show, chief of the California Region. This is an increase of \$57,000 over the federal allotment for last year, and \$90,000 more than was received by the state in 1928.
