REPUBLICANS LEAD STATE FOUR TO ONE

California Registration Is Largest in History for Primaries

SACRAMENTO, (UP)—Los Angeles county, with a total registration of 821,886, ranked first among the 58 counties of California in total registration for the August 26 primary election.

This was announced here today by Secretary of State Frank C. Jordan, whose compilation showed that at the primary election in 1926 the county's registration was 661,449.

The Golden State registered a heavy gain in voting strength by this year's registration which, for the first time, went over the

two-million mark, Jordan said. The exact figure was 2,187,474, as compared to 1,854,471 four years ago.

Voting precincts also increased from 3,332 in 1926 to 10,233 at the present time.

California still retains its ratio of four Republicans to one Democrat; the total for the 58 counties of the state, by party affiliation, being as follows:

Republican, 1,599,413; Democratic, 449,821; Prohibition, 12,304; Socialist, 10,922; declined to state, 114,910; and miscellaneous, 391.

Los Angeles, as usual, stood first in registration with a total of 821,886 voters, as compared to 661,444 four years ago. San Francisco came next, with 245,019 against 220,893 in 1926, while Alameda ranked third, with 237,674 as compared with 198,265.

Alpine, California's tiniest county, registered 126 voters for the state primary—126 Republicans and 10 Democrats. At the primary election four years ago this county's total registration was only 86, of whom 71 actually cast their votes for governor.
