## Armistice Sunday to Be Observed Here With Union Church Service

With the Bert S. Crossland Post of the American Legion and the local Legion auxiliary unit as guests of honor, Armistice Sunday, November 9, will be observed at the Torrance high school auditorium with a union church service. The program will begin at 11 o'clock Sunday morning.


