

STARLETS ON UNUSUAL PROGRAM



Hollywood Baby Orchestra (from three to six years old) which
will give a special concert performance Friday night under the
auspices of the Torrance Masonic Lodge, the entire proceeds to go
to the Torrance Relief Society for the assistance of needy families
within the city limits.

No bearded baton-waver, no aged task-
master will rap for silence on his music
stand as the orchestra awaits his signal to
begin tomorrow, Friday, evening at 7:30
o'clock when the Torrance Masons present
a most unusual program at the high school
auditorium.

—And no adult musicians, bald-pated,
be-spectacled or otherwise will sit tense
and waiting the directorship of his arms
that will commence the concert.

Instead—babies, mere babies—will
comprise the entire orchestra and will
play to the direction of child-concert
master!

Present Complete Program

Ranging from three to six years old,
these accomplished children, the Hollywood
Baby Orchestra, will sit on the Torrance
high school auditorium stage and will pre-
sent a program that is absolutely unique in
entertainment!

Amplifying their concert numbers,
the child-artists stage recitations, solo
musical selections and playlets de-
signed to please even the most critical
of their audience.

Every cent realized from the sale of the
tickets, 35 cents for adults and 25 cents
for children, will be given to the Torrance
Relief Society so that that organization
may carry on the good work in assisting
local families through this period of stress.

All Skilled Musicians

If there ever was a worthy cause—this is
it. But the Torrance Masons want the
people of this and surrounding cities to
know that the Hollywood Baby Orchestra
is NOT a group of children banded together
in the hopes that what they play may be
termed "music" in the broadest sense of
the word.

The little tots are—each and every
one of them—skilled, accomplished mu-
sicians. They are not toddlers "foolin'
around" with play-instruments, but
they are serious students of their tiny
violins, cellos and bass viols. Their
program includes some intricate classi-
cal as well as popular orchestrations.

Karl Moldrem is the guiding genius be-
hind the Hollywood Baby Orchestra and
he has carefully chosen the most adept
youngsters to come to Torrance tomor-
row night to present the concert program.
Although Moldrem cannot say in advance
just how many babies will make up the
orchestra—because of illness in the home,
the distance or the many other reasons
that govern a child's evenings, he is plan-
ning on presenting to the audience the
same type of program that has won the
admiration of scores of other gatherings
which have marveled at the faultless play-
ing of the child-musicians.

of little folks, from three to six years old,
attractively dressed in black velvet Eton
suits ruffled with white at the throat and
chubby wrists, playing familiar tunes in
perfect time, perfect tone and faultless ex-
ecution! The baby maestro, his spun-gold
fuzzy hair, waving with all the abandon of
his older fellow-directors', sweeping his
baton through measure after measure as
serious as his musicians before him!
