 AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE, CALIFORNIA, CALLING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF TORRANCE ON THE 9TH DAY OF JUNE, 1931, AND PROVIDING FOR SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS OF SAID CITY THE PROPOSITION OF INCURRING AN INDEBTEDNESS FOR THE ACQUISITION, CONSTRUCTION AND COMPLETION OF PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS WITHIN SAID CITY AND PROVIDING FOR THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS THEREFOR, FOR THE LEVYING OF A TAX FOR THE PAYMENT OF SAID BONDS, CONSOLIDATING ELECTION PRECINCTS, DESIGNATING THE POLLING PLACES AND APPOINTING ELECTION OFFICERS FOR SAID CONSOLIDATED ELECTION, AND CONSOLIDATING SAID ELECTION WITH AN ELECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF CHOOSING FIFTEEN FREEHOLDERS UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 8 OF ARTICLE XI OF THE CALIFORNIA CONSTITUTION.
 The City Council of the City of Torrance do ordain as follows:
 Section 1
 It appears to the City Council of the City of Torrance after a hearing on said question that the public interest, convenience and necessity require and demand the acquisition, construction and completion of parks and playgrounds within the said city, and that the estimated cost of said work is the sum of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00); that said estimated cost is and will be too great to be paid out of the ordinary annual income and revenue of said City of Torrance, and said City Council having on the 7th day of April, 1931, by resolution No. 492 passed by vote of two-thirds of all its members determined that the public interest and necessity demand such acquisition, construction and completion.
 Section 2
 Now, therefore, it is hereby ordered that an election be held, and an election is hereby called to be held on the 9th day of June, 1931, throughout the City of Torrance for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of said city the proposition of incurring a bonded indebtedness by the City of Torrance of One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$150,000.00) for the purposes hereinafter set forth, said election to be held under the provisions of that certain act of the Legislature of the State of California, entitled "An Act authorizing the incurring of indebtedness by cities, towns and municipal corporations for municipal improvement, and regulating the acquisition, construction or completion thereof," approved February 25, 1901.
 Section 3
 That for the purpose of said election there shall be added to the ballot to be used thereat in addition to other matters required by law for elections in Fifth and Sixth Class cities, the following proposition, to-wit: "Shall the City of Torrance incur a bonded debt of \$150,000.00 for the purpose of acquisition, construction and completion of parks and playgrounds within the City of Torrance, including landscaping and the construction of swimming pool, athletic equipment, walks, drives and roadways therein and in connection therewith, and of the equipment and conveniences reasonably necessary for the use of said parks and playgrounds?"
