Cruises to Nowhere Planned By Lasso: Will Start June 13

Four "Cruises to Nowhere," designed to afford Southern Californians the opportunities for a pleasant and stimulating sea voyage of longer duration than the overnight trip to San Francisco or the daylight voyage to San Diego and yet not requiring the time necessary for a trip to Hawaii, were announced today by the Los Angeles Steamship Company as a special feature of the line's service this summer.

The Lasso, flying the S. S. City of Los Angeles, which normally lays over at her home port of Los Angeles for eight days following the conclusion of a voyage to Hawaii, sailing again the second Saturday after arrival, is the steamer chosen for the intermediate service.

What Cruise Includes Catalina and San Clemente Islands will be passed the first afternoon out; Coronado Island will be seen early the following morning; then Today Santos Island will be rounded and the liner put in at Ensenada, Lower California, shortly after breakfast.

Similar cruises will also be operated on the same liner and over substantially the same course from Los Angeles July 11, August 8 and September 5.
