
Tests For Nautical School October 2; 65 Will Be Chosen

SACRAMENTO, — Examinations for admission to the California nautical school will be held October 2, the state department of education announced recently.

The examinations will be given at Arcata, Fresno, Los Angeles, San Diego, San Luis Obispo, San Francisco, Chico, Santa Barbara and Sacramento.

Following the tests, approximately 65 cadets will be appointed. The school's shore base and training vessels are located at Thurston, Marin county. The school is conducted by the state to train officers for the United States merchant marine.
