Ask Protection For Fishermen Against Mex. License Brokers

The board of supervisors this week called the attention of Mexican authorities to what Supervisor John R. Quinn asserted was activity on the part of Mexican "license brokers" which practically amounted to a racket in extracting "fines" from American fishermen. Mexican law provides that persons fishing in Mexican waters must have a Mexican license, it was explained. Quinn stated that in some instances fishing vessels from San Pedro have become disabled, found drifting in Mexican waters, and their owners have been forced to pay heavy fines because of having no license. The supervisor asked closer supervision of issuance of these licenses by the Mexican government.
