


War Nurse Heads Legion Post

Here and There with the Girl Scouts





DALLAS, Tex. (U.P.)—Southern Methodist followers are picking Robert Edward Wilson for all-American honors this season.

He's a little fellow—weighing only 145—but he's the sparkplug of the S. M. U. offense, and as fast a back as any on a South-west Conference team.

For two years Wilson has been the class of the conference, and this year, he is going stronger than ever. He is considered one of the finest broken field runners in the country.

New Yorkers who saw the Fordham-S.M.U. game last year probably remember Wilson. He was the little fellow who played only five or six minutes. He entered the game when S.M.U. was behind. He left the game a few minutes later, after making two touchdowns and putting the Ponies ahead.

Wilson won a place on the S.M.U. varsity in 1933. That year he scored 48 points to top individual scorers in the conference. In 1934 he led again with the same number of points.

As a freshman he did not appear a future great, but played a steady game. It was not until his sophomore year when he made the varsity that the "Mustang Mite" became the idol of S.M.U. followers.


