**Around the  
Council Table**

Councilman Tolson presided at the meeting held Wednesday afternoon, July 1, Mayor Stanger being absent due to the illness of his mother.

On recommendation of the chamber of commerce, \$450 was appropriated to defray the expenses of Louis Zamperini, track star, to New York and the Olympic Games at Berlin. In case Zamperini doesn't qualify at New York for the Olympics, \$150 is to be returned. Dr. Abden W. Smith addressed the council in support of the appropriation.

Another recommendation of the chamber of commerce that the city purchase a piano for the auditorium was denied.

Payment of \$150 to the Torrance Municipal Band for the part in the civic building dedication ceremonies was approved. \$89 of the amount being the balance of a former allotment.

An offer of the Dominguez Water Company to provide a stand-by reserve supply of water at a monthly rate of \$100 was declined.

City's contribution for water on the WPA farm project will not exceed \$100 per month, WPA officials agreeing to pay the balance. Last month the city furnished \$217 worth of water. Thirty-one Torrance citizens are employed on the federal project.

Contract with the County to supply library services at \$8000 per year was approved. This service covers salaries of personnel, books, etc. It is \$1000 less than the amount paid last year.
