NEW TYPE AIR-CONDITIONED ICE REFRIGERATOR IS GRAND PRIZE AT COOKING SCHOOL

At the forthcoming Cooking School to be held this week, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday, in the Torrance civic auditorium, housewives will have the opportunity of inspecting the new type air-conditioned ice refrigerator which is one of the outstanding favorites during the 1936 season.

Nina G. Abbey will demonstrate the new refrigerator. It is a one-door Albatross 75-pound capacity ice refrigerator. It embodies an enclosed compartment for the ice, and is of all-metal construction with heavily insulated walls. It is streamlined and finished with full porcelain interior.

Low Cost
The surprising feature is the low price of the refrigerator which actually effects a first-cost saving considerably more than \$100.00 to the purchaser.

The Union Ice Company serving this community is the contributing sponsor of the Cooking School, having arranged for Mrs. Abbey to direct the demonstration and to give guests a resume of her experience in the preparation of new dishes. Mrs. Abbey is thoroughly experienced in the value of air-conditioned ice refrigeration and will discuss the preservation of foods, summer refrigeration, proper placement of foods in refrigerators, etc. She will offer to guests a number of excellent recipes for the preparation of frozen desserts and other attractive dishes in which ice or low temperatures are required.

Slower Meltage
Refrigeration engineers of the local ice companies have conducted tests of various ice refrigerators in comparison with this new prize model. In checking ice meltage of the old wooden boxes of rather "ancient vintage," such as were manufactured 10 or 15 years ago, it was found that this newest model, 75-pound capacity, with its enlarged shelf area and efficiently directed air circulation currents, accommodates as much food as an older model using 100 or more pounds of ice. The meltage is much slower because of extra-heavy insulation.

It is pointed out that a saving in ice, by installing the new refrigerator, goes a long way toward making the payments so that actually the new purchase costs very little.

Another feature which can be noted only by actual inspection, is the beauty of finish. Genuine porcelain interiors is a feature of most of the new models. FIT-


