

Executive Predicts Great Advance for Diesel Motors

Toys Reflect Machine Age

Young America's Christmas stocking this year will reflect a machine age rather than a military age. Transportation toys, with many new and improved features, are likely to head the list and jam Santa's pack.

A peek into toyland reveals: Pint size motor cars that hum like authentic engines turning over, streamlined sleds with "airplane decks," headlights that can be dimmed or brightened, a new wheel toy model with free wheeling, doll carriages and velocipedes with pneumatic tires and parking brakes, and dump trucks and fire engines with aerodynamic streamlining.

Building Sets Popular For air-minded youngsters hundreds of model building sets which reproduce different types of commercial airliners were shown at the Toy Association preview here.

The toy parade of streamlined trains include every new model in railroading. Illuminated passenger cars, observation cars and true-to-life whistles are some of the new features. A six-wheel electric locomotive, formerly a model maker's luxury, has been manufactured for the first time.

With a new version of the electric eye, boys can control electric train sets by a wave of a hand. With an optical lens set children can build their own microscopes and kaleidoscopes.

More Handicraft Toys A new development in handicraft toys is an electric pencil which can be utilized to do woodburning from stencil outlines. The woodburning is done on plywood plaques. A tapestry weaving set is another development in handicraft play. Mirror drawing devices with electric lights have been perfected so

Diesel power is only in its infancy, yet those who have watched its advance predict that we are on the brink of one of the major shifts in the world's sources of power. One of the interested observers of the Diesel motor is J. D. Spaulding, assistant vice president of the National Supply Company.

This firm is identified with what is believed to be the oldest four-cycle auto engine works in the U. S.—the Otto Engine Company of Philadelphia, manufacturers of Superior Diesel engines. Spaulding takes a keen interest in the development of the Diesel and he joins other authorities on this subject in predicting a major trend away from gasoline engines and into Diesel engines for a large number of automotive tasks.

Boon for Oil Industry However, he believes that the gasoline engine has a definite place in the field of transportation and is content with prophesying that in the field of passenger cars, Diesels will take over only those where the per-mile cost is of major importance.

The most startling effect of Diesels that engineers foresee will come in the oil industry, from the producers to the retail outlets. These changes, they point out, should be all for good. At the present time the demand is for gasoline, which is among the higher fractions in crude petroleum. Refiners have a surplus of other fractions. When Diesels are used in large quantity, they are bound to improve this situation, it is said.
