STUFFED FISH ROLLS WITH SPINACH GOLDENROD
1 cup bread crumbs
Minced onion
Butter, salt, pepper
1 1/2 lbs. fish filets
Cooked spinach
1 or 2 hard-cooked eggs
Toss bread crumbs and onion in a little melted butter, season with salt and pepper. Cut filets into long oblong pieces about 2x5 inches, season with salt and pepper, spread with bread mixture, roll and fasten with toothpicks. Place filets on oven-proof platter, brush with butter, bake in slow oven, 300° F., for 30 minutes. Arrange hot cooked well-seasoned spinach around fish rolls. Garnish with chopped egg, or with egg forced thru a sieve.
