

All MacDowell Program Tonight at Woman's Clubhouse

Auxiliary Singers, Billini and Players Will Entertain

Best remembered for his "To a Wild Rose" and "To a Water Lily," the late great composer, Edward A. MacDowell, will be paid signal tribute at the Woman's clubhouse tonight when the American Legion Auxiliary glee club will present its "MacDowell concert," with Mme. Teala Billini and the Ramona Players of Los Angeles as assisting artists.

The concert program will be devoted to a carefully-chosen selection of the American composer's works and Mme. Billini will present piano compositions of distinctive merit while the Players are to stage a dramatic episode from the life of the man who died in 1908.

All proceeds from the concert will be put in a special fund being raised by the Legion Auxiliary to buy new uniforms next year. The program will begin at 8 o'clock and the tickets are 25 cents.

Depict Colony Life
The glee club will open the concert with MacDowell's "Pillgrims' Chorus." The Ramona Players are to present "A Visit to Peterboro," written by Cara Frierson, their director who is also director of the glee club. Peterboro, located in New Hampshire, is the locale of the MacDowell Colony, organized in 1909 by Mrs. MacDowell in memory of her distinguished husband as a haven for writers, artists and composers. The colony is conducted along the composer's own plan for interrelation of the arts.

"Thy Beaming Eyes" and "Cradle Song" are next on the program, followed by Mme. Billini's piano numbers by MacDowell, No. 46, Impromptu and Moto Perpetuo. The glee club will be heard in the famed Woodland Sketches.
