HERMOSA BEACH.—The third annual 42-mile aquaplane race from Santa Catalina Island to the Southern California coast will be staged on Aug. 1.

President Tom Hammond, heading the Hermosa Beach Manhattan Beach backers of the event, predicted a record number of 25 contestants would enter the gruelling race which last year drew a shore crowd of many thousands to the two resorts.

Bob Duntley, college student and winner over 20 other starters last year, Jack (Cocky) Barud, 1935 winner, and Frank Sandeman, Long Beach fireman and ex-soldier, a starter in two previous races, have signed up for the 1937 race.

It was Sandeman who made the aquaplane journey first four years ago and originated the idea of the novel affair.

Nimrod B. J. (Scotty) Scott brought home the bacon literally and figuratively, last Sunday when he returned from a trip to Catalina Island with the limit in wild goats and one wild boar as trophies. The hunt was a great success for all members of the party, each of whom bagged the limit of three goats, one of which had a horn-spread of 33 inches, the largest ever taken on the island. The lucky hunter who knocked over this goat will have the head mounted.

While the island is plentifully supplied with wild goats, the hunter who captures a wild boar is considered very fortunate, as these animals are hard to locate.

Imported several years ago to combat a pest of rattlesnakes, the boars have increased in numbers but not to any great extent and as they are extremely shy and cunning, and keep to the wilder parts of the island, their capture is infrequent. The boar killed by Scotty Sunday was the only one seen all day. The wild pigs have cleared the island of most of its snakes and in the course of time the island will again be free of its dangerous inhabitants. The origin of rattlers on the island is unknown. Years ago snakes were non-existent on Catalina, an island which rose from the sea thousands of years ago during one of the periodic upheavals of this region.

Some years ago, after the island had become a resort rattlers were discovered to be present and in a short time had become so numerous as to be a menace to inhabitants and visitors.

It is believed that someone with a malicious sense of humor brought over a small consignment secretly and turned them loose.

Would Form Water District In No. Torrance

The troublesome problem of providing water service for residents of North Torrance got a step nearer solution this week when a delegation from North Torrance appeared before the city council Tuesday evening. After a long series of questions in which spokesmen for the northern residents endeavored to pin down city officials to a definite commitment on costs of the proposed water project, a petition signed by 14 residents was filed.

The petition formally requested the formation of an assessment district following a majority vote on the issue for the purpose of laying water mains on Arlington avenue between 182nd and 166th streets as well as for 660 feet on 166th street. The proposed district would embrace the frontage on Arlington for approximately one and one-eighth miles and extend back on either side for 600 feet, totaling about 160 acres. Representatives of the property owners agreed to meet with City Engineer Leonard Thursday afternoon to outline the definite boundaries of the proposed assessment district. Leonard in turn stated that he would have a report to submit on July 27 covering the estimated cost of the project.




