Would Restrict Jobs to County Residents

Employers in Los Angeles county will be urged by the L. A. chamber of commerce to "keep Los Angeles' jobs for Los Angeles residents" in cooperation with a move launched recently by the board of supervisors.

The chamber also asked that the county enforce rigid restrictions denying relief to non-residents of the county, because new arrivals and "outsiders" are causing a heavy expenditure for relief, while some are competing with the persons who now pay taxes to the county.

Find Oil Traces On P. V. Slope

Oil production possibilities on the north flank of Palos Verdes took a forward step Tuesday with the finding of streaks of oil sand below 1,100 feet in Rolling Hills Petroleum's wildcat on Highway 101 between Redondo and Waverly.

The test is reported 800 feet west of McClaren No. 1, which yielded small amounts of oil for a short time from 1,625 feet. Marie Humphries, one of the first women to take charge of drilling operations in the state, is supervising the work.

Christmas shopping and wet weather combine to make November and December the most dangerous months of the year.

Although the holiday season usually is associated with happiness, tragedy often strikes as the result of heavy street traffic and pedestrian movement.

Approximately 24 percent of all 1936 Los Angeles county traffic fatalities occurred in the last two months of the year. Largely responsible for the heavy death toll was the increase of accidents involving pedestrians.

Increased alertness and obedience to law on the part of both motorists and pedestrians are needed if any reduction in holiday accidents is to be accomplished.

Pedestrians are urged to look both ways before crossing a street. Avoid jaywalking and stay inside the pedestrian lanes. In wet weather play safe and make greater allowances for stopping distances required by vehicles on the slick streets.

Motorist and pedestrian alike can do his part by remembering that the Christmas spirit should be radiated, not consumed.

You Need Permit To Cut Yule Tree

Don't plan on going to the mountains to cut down a free Christmas tree. Officers have been appointed this year to apprehend persons having illegal possession or engaged in cutting Christmas trees on national forest lands without written permission of the U. S. Forest Service.

Several trespass cases were successfully prosecuted last year because defendants failed to secure permits before cutting trees. There are areas in several forests where tree cutting is allowed but a permit is required in all cases.
