### Work Week for Steel Employees Highest Since '30

Asked in New York City what the average hours of work of the United States Steel Corporation had been during the past year, Myron C. Taylor, chairman of the board, replied:

"Reports for the first nine months which are available indicate that the employees of the Corporation worked an average of 39.98 hours per week during that period. This is the highest average for a similar period that has been maintained since 1930. In all the years since that time, including 1937, the average weekly hours in the Corporation have been less than 40, while the number of employees has steadily risen to a peak in the month of August 1937, when 278,178 were engaged. The present policy continues to be that which was adopted in 1930 of spreading the work."
