



**CAKES, MUFFINS
CANDIES ETC.**

JOHNNY CAKE

1 1/2 cups corn meal
1 1/2 cups flour
4 tsp. baking powder
1 tsp. salt
4 tbsps. sugar
6 tbsps. butter
3 eggs, separated
1 1/2 cups milk

Sift all the dry ingredients together. Beat egg yolks, adding milk and melted butter. Combine with dry ingredients. Beat egg whites stiff and fold into mixture. Turn into well buttered pan and bake in oven at 400 degrees F.

GRAPENUT BREAD

1 cup Grapenuts
2 cups milk
1/2 cup sugar
1 egg
3 cups flour, sifted
4 tsp. baking powder
1 tsp. salt

Soak grapenuts in milk for half hour. Add sugar and egg which has been beaten slightly. Add flour sifted with baking powder and salt. Mix thoroughly. Pour into buttered bread pan. Bake one hour in moderate oven (350 degrees F.).

DANISH PASTRY

2 cups milk, scalded
2 cakes yeast
6 tbsps. sugar
6 tbsps. butter
8 cups flour
3/4 lb. unsalted butter
3 eggs
1 tsp. salt

Scald milk and allow to cool to lukewarm. Add yeast, sugar and 6 tsp. butter. Add sifted flour and salt. Mix into a dough and knead about 5 minutes. Roll dough into oblong piece. Cut the unsalted butter into small pieces and arrange on 1/2 of the dough (in center). Take a portion of the dough without butter and fold over the buttered dough. Dot with butter and fold remaining 1/2 dough over the butter. This will make three thicknesses of dough. Press down edges and roll out about 1/4 inch thick. Fold three times and roll out again. Fold again and allow to rise. Shape rolls into crescents, squares, etc., and allow to rise. Bake in oven at 375 degrees F.

STREUSEL APPLE CAKE

3 cups sifted all purpose flour
4 1/2 tsp. baking powder
1 tsp. salt
1/2 cup sugar
1 egg, well beaten
1 1/2 cups milk
3 tbsps. melted butter
3 apples

Sift dry ingredients together. Mix egg, milk and butter. Add to dry ingredients. Pour into buttered baking pan. Pare and core apples and cut into eighths. Arrange in rows, sticking narrow end into dough. Sprinkle with streusel topping and let stand five minutes. Bake in moderate oven (350 degrees F.) 30 minutes. STREUSEL: 1/3 tbsps. brown sugar, 4 tbsps. flour, 6 tbsps. soft butter, 5 tbsps. chopped nuts. Mix thoroughly.

CHOCOLATE CARAMELS

2 cups granulated sugar
2 cups brown sugar
1 cup light corn syrup
2 cups rich milk
1/2 cup butter
4 sq. bitter chocolate

Combine all ingredients in a heavy saucepan. Cook over low flame. Stir constantly until it reaches the hard ball stage (288 degrees F.). Remove from fire. Pour into square pan which has been generously spread with butter. When cool, mark into squares. Allow candy to become firm. Cut into squares and wrap in waxed paper.

**ASPARAGUS
FOR ENTREE**

Entrees suited to be served as the main dish of luncheon or supper are popular today. They offer a change from the customary meat dishes and at the same time help to ease the strain on

the food budget.

Asparagus rolls with devilled ham sauce are one of the types of entrees you will find worth trying and repeating. Cut French rolls in half lengthwise, and scoop out the inside of the roll. Fry these shells in deep fat, or brush with melted butter and brown them in the oven. Meantime, make a very good white sauce to which has been added

a can of devilled ham. When ready to serve, fill the roll shells with hot asparagus and over the tips pour the devilled ham sauce. Sprinkle with chopped parsley. The asparagus is canned in three styles, all white, all green, or white with green tips. Any one of these is good to serve in the rolls.

Another easy asparagus entree is made with cheese and eggs. Make a well seasoned white sauce to which has been added a liberal amount of strong American cheese. In a greased casserole arrange layers of asparagus tips, or broken pieces of asparagus (cut pieces can be bought in cans, too) and alternate with layers of sliced hard cooked eggs and cheese sauce. Sprinkle buttered bread crumbs

over the top and bake until the crumbs are brown and the food hot, or about 30 minutes in a moderate oven.

With either one of these entrees all that is needed to complete the meal is a mixed green salad, or one made with a can of mixed vegetables and French dressing, and then some canned spiced fruit such as pears or peaches. It would be

well to have a hearty dessert like mince pie or a steamed pudding. These sound elaborate but just remember that the filling for the pie comes in cans and likewise the pudding, so there is very little left to do to get them ready for the meal.
