Heirs Ask \$25,000 Damages for Death of Worker Here

Damages of \$25,000 are sought for the death of Clark Dolan, fatally injured in a fall from a scaffold in the plant of the National Supply company Jan. 9, 1937, in a complaint on file this week in Los Angeles county superior court.

William Dolan and Sadie Dolan are the plaintiffs in the action, as heirs-at-law of the accident victim, the complaint states.

The complaint is similar to the action brought last week by Frank Gibson, who was injured in the same accident and who now seeks \$50,000 damages. Both Gibson and Dolan were employed by the Townsend Glass company of Los Angeles to make repairs at the local plant and were under sub-contract to that firm. Neither were employed by the National Supply company. In both actions, James O. Bishop, master mechanic, is included as co-defendant.
