A gain of 13 1/2 percent in gross receipts at the Lomita postoffice for the fiscal year 1937-38 over the previous year was reported by Postmaster Birda Paddock this week. The receipts totaled more than \$13,000. The last quarter's business, which was low for the year, showed a 3 1/2 percent over the same quarter in 1937.

Money order issues from the Lomita office amounted to about \$160,000, which is unusually high for a second-class postal center in a community the size of Lomita. This business, by postal regulations, cannot be figured in gross receipts. The money order business showed a 17 percent gain over last year and more than 300 percent over the amount of business done four years ago.

Contrary to popular belief, the 17th District Congressional office in Washington is not closed, according to a communication from Clara N. Golden, widow of former Congressman Chas. J. Golden.

ORDINANCE NO. 304

ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TORRANCE ESTABLISHING BOULEVARD STOPS, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AND AMENDING PORTION OF ORDINANCE NO. 260.

The City Council of the City of Torrance does hereby ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 260 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following:

It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to operate or cause to be operated any motor vehicle upon, along and/or across the intersection of Madrid Avenue and Sonoma Street in the City of Torrance, when any such vehicle is being operated in a northerly or southerly direction on Madrid Avenue, without first bringing such motor vehicle to a complete stop immediately prior to entering said intersection of said two highways.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions hereof shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars, or by imprisonment for not more than fifty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this Ordinance by the said City Council, and shall cause the same to be published once in the Torrance Herald, a weekly newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the City of Torrance, and thereupon and thereafter the same shall be in full force and effect.
