One of the oldest retail establishments in Torrance changed ownership this week as S. S. Worrell, veteran hardware man, sold his store at 1517 Cabrillo avenue to George H. Moore, who with Mrs. Moore and their seven-months old son, George, is moving from Glendale to make their home at 1416 Beech avenue.

Moore is a native son of California, born in Glendale. Following graduation from the Glendale high school, he attended the University of Southern California. Recently he has been studying law at night and will soon be eligible to take the state bar examination.

"It is not my intention to practice law, however," Moore said, "but I do believe a thorough knowledge of legal procedure is valuable to anyone in business."

Since he finished college, Moore has worked three years in his father's law office in Los Angeles, and another three years in the service department of the Southern California Gas company.
