

BAN HEAVY TRAFFIC ON 5 STREETS

City Attorney John E. McCall was instructed by the city council Tuesday night to prepare an ordinance prohibiting heavy trucking on Plaza del Amo, 218th, 220th, Andreo and Gramery streets from Arlington to Cabrillo avenue.

This was in response to a petition from Plaza del Amo residents who protested several weeks ago about the heavy traffic over their street by oil trucks enroute to the city dump.

Altho several of the above streets were posted to prevent such traffic several years ago and a number of arrests were made, Police Chief John Stroh pointed out that no ordinance was adopted at that time to back up the posting.

Colorado Water Will Be Costly, Citizens Told

ing well water at the municipal district plant.

Wide Variance in Costs

Attorney C. T. Rippy, official representative of Torrance on the Metropolitan Water District board, explained that any funds derived from the sale of water in this city would be deducted from the tax levy, and that "as long as we are going to have to pay for the Colorado River water whether we use it or not, we might as well use it."

Torrance's allotment of water from the MWD is 8,500 acre feet, which at the estimated rate of \$15 per acre foot would total about \$127,000 per year. Present pumping costs are \$7,000 per year, Stanger stated.

After a prolonged discussion, led by Stanger and Rippy on comparative costs, the matter of treatment of the Colorado River water and its adaptability for industrial, agricultural, and domestic uses was presented.

It was finally decided at Stanger's suggestion to prepare a group of questions to be presented to Metropolitan Water District officials for study, and then call another meeting of local representatives and MWD engineers. Aside from Director Rippy, there were no other MWD officials present at yesterday's meeting.

More than 1,000 parcels of tax-deeded property in Torrance and other sections of the county will be sold at public auction within the next few weeks, by an order of the board of supervisors. It will be the first sale of property deeded to the state for non-payment of taxes for many years.

Already some 500 persons have signified their desire to buy some of the tax-deeded real estate. Examination of the list of parcels discloses that some of it has been deeded to the state since 1895, altho most of it dates back only 20 years. Size of the
