'Union Pacific' at Gardena

Barbara Stanwyck, in a role completely different from any she has previously attempted, and Joel McCrea, as a character strongly reminiscent of the one he portrayed last season in "Wells Fargo," are co-starred in the romantic leads of "Union Pacific," Cecil B. No County Funds for Memorial Halls This Year

By a vote of four to one, the board of supervisors has adopted a policy of not setting up any funds in next year's county budget toward the construction of memorial halls inside cities.

"Four members of the board out-voted Supervisor Oscar Hauge of the Fourth district on a petition of Compton citizens, asking that \$25,000 be set up next year for a building that would provide a much-needed meeting place for veterans organizations of that community.

"If we do this for one city we'll have to do it for all of them," Chairman Roger Jessup said. "We cannot do this, and it would not be fair to give funds to one city and not to the rest." Somewhat of a precedent was set several years ago, when the supervisors set up \$75,000 two years in succession for construction of a large memorial hall for accommodation of the many service men and ex-service groups in the harbor district, the building being in Long Beach.

Oldsmobile Sales Show Big Increase

Oldsmobile retail sales for the month of June were 83 percent ahead of the same month last year with a total of 12,545 cars for the month compared to 6,860 a year ago, according to Mul-lin Service, Torrance dealers for Oldsmobile.

Retail sales for the last 10 days of June totaled 4,901 cars, representing a gain of 80 percent over the 2,729 cars sold in the same period in 1938. For the first six months of 1939, Oldsmobile dealers have sold 73,348 cars, a gain of 32 percent over the 48,229 cars sold in the first six months a year ago.
